

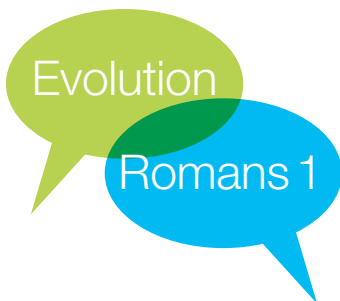
Adult Bible Education Summer Quarter 2017

Exodus

Utilizing various hermeneutical (interpretative) tools, teachers will guide the class through an inductive study of Exodus. God has one central purpose for the book of Exodus: He wills to be known and glorified. His glory is manifested in the deliverance of His people from slavery in Egypt. Exodus is pointing us forward to God's final deliverance of His people from their bondage to sin. The story line of Exodus foreshadows the Gospel, so we will seek to understand its redemptive purposes in relation to Jesus Christ. This is the second quarter of a two quarter class. Everyday Apologetics

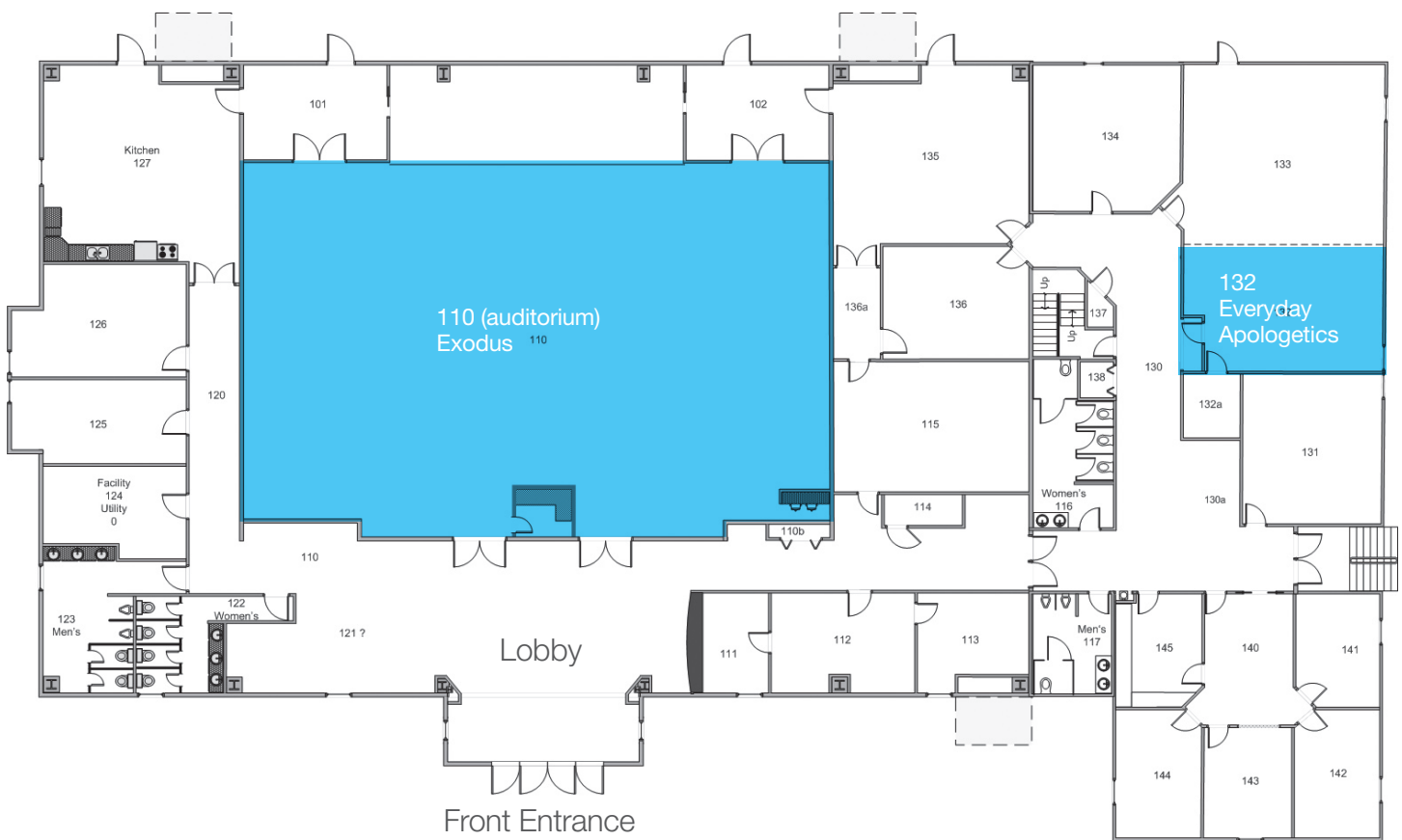
