You have been asked to come alongside those who are seeking counseling at the Chapel Counseling Center. Thank you for being willing to help them by investing your lives on their behalf and enjoying a front row seat as God works in them giving them the desire and ability to become more and more like Christ, for His glory and the good of these fellow believers.

Here are your responsibilities in accepting your ministry as Support Partners:

- 1. Attend all counseling sessions with the counselees.
- 2. Observe the counseling sessions in order to hold the counselees accountable for the weekly homework assigned. The counselees may also need your assistance with their homework.
- 3. Come to the aid of the counselees in situations that arise during the week.
- 4. Give feedback to the counselor whenever something is taught in the session that is not in line with what is taught at your local church. This will alert the counselor of a potential conflict in what is taught in the sessions and the teaching of your local church.
- 5. Keep your local church leadership updated on the progress of the counselees as you deem appropriate.
- 6. When the counselor has determined the crisis, for which they initially sought counsel, has been adequately addressed, counseling will be terminated and you will have the responsibility to continue any regular discipleship you deem necessary for the counselees as part of the ongoing care by your local church.
