The Advanced Modules

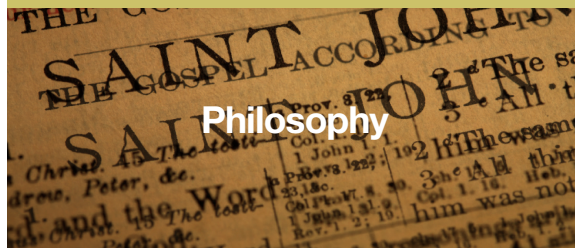

A Biblical Understanding of the Conscience

Saturday, February 19th 9:00am-12:00pm

Conscience is a word to represent the heart function which informs us that we have violated our ethical/moral/Biblical norms. Our conscience approves or disapproves our thoughts and actions. This is the way we use the word in our normal, ordinary talk as Christians. However, we are using a term that sometimes, we know very little about. Having a Biblical understanding of the conscience will help us in the ministry of our counseling.

Our sanctification is dependent on relationships. God created us to be in community so that should be no surprise! But for many men, cultural paradigms and our own propensity to be independent in mind and spirit tell us that we don't need other people. Helping Women in Difficult Marriages

In this session we will discuss how can we point them to Christ, encourage them to respond well and not sin in their response. We will discuss this important topic and the different aspects involved. This session will explore these areas and help you counsel well.
