## Neighborhood Fall Outreach

As I write this, it is 95° outside but within a few weeks Fall will be in the air. In past years we have offered gospel tracts to our Flocks to be handed out during trick or treat. This year I'd like to offer a few different suggestions to those in our church family that will help you personally engage your neighbors.

- ◇ Sit out on your front porch or in your driveway. Resist the temptation to sit inside your house waiting for the doorbell to ring. You'll find that you will have opportunity to strike up short conversations with neighbors that you may have never met before.
- ◇ Make a game out in your front yard or driveway that gives trick-or-treaters the opportunity to win a big candy bar. It could be as simple as a bean bag toss or throwing a ball to knock something down. Make it simple. While kids want to hit every house on your block, but this will make a great impression.
- ◇ Set up a table in your driveway and offer free coffee or hot chocolate to parents who are out with their children. This is another opportunity for short little conversations as parents move up and down your street.
- ◇ When we lived on a cul-de-sac, all of the families on the street set up tables in the middle of the street and handed out candy together. This was a great opportunity to get to know our neighbors over the extended time of trick-or-treat. In your neighborhood there might be single parents or elderly who are often ignored as neighbors. Getting together like this brings your neighborhood together in a very special way.

This Halloween many of your neighbors will likely walk up to your door and ring the bell. Let's use this opportunity to extend a welcome to them. ~ Pastor Tim Nixon
